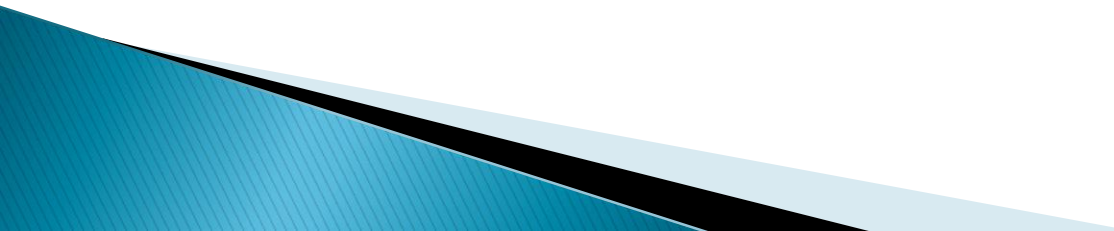

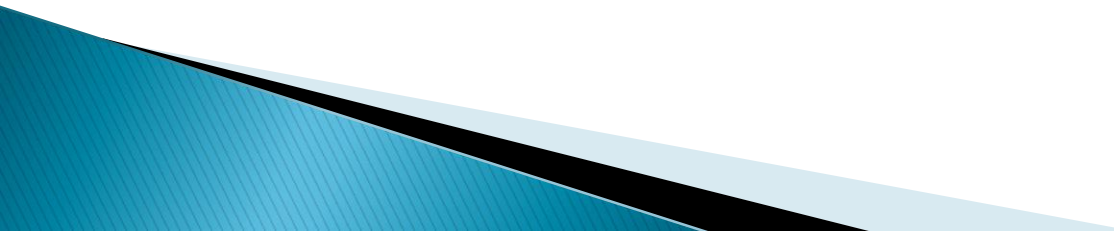
General Requirements

- ▶ 2 years in college for AAS
- ▶ 2 years in university (only at Rush university)
- ▶ Offered by the College of health Science at Rush University, the Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Care is a professional degree.
- ▶ Entering students will have completed at least 60 semester hours of undergraduate coursework to include pre-requisite course work in mathematics,
- ▶ communications, psychology, chemistry, anatomy and physiology, microbiology, and physics.
- ▶ The program is two years in length at the upper division, undergraduate level. The initial enrollment for the program is expected to be 12 students per year.
